This beautiful and inspiring picture book about a little-known 20th-century African-American fashion designer shines a light on how the great-granddaughter of a slave and a plantation owner became society's most sought after fashion secret.



Practically as soon as Ann Cole Lowe could walk, she learned to sew from her grandmother and mother and worked in the family's seamstress shop in Alabama, making glorious dresses for Montgomery society women who went to fancy parties. When Ann was 16, her mother died, and Ann finished the ball gowns the older woman had been working on. She then went to design school in New York City in 1917 but had to learn alone, segregated from the rest of the class. Though her race required that she often work anonymously, her creations achieved soaring success, including First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy's wedding dress and the gown Olivia de Havilland wore to accept the Academy Award for Best Actress. Ultimately recognized for her work, this attractive picture book focuses on the lifetime career of a little-known visionary. Ann Cole Lowe persevered in times of hardship, always doing what she was passionate about: making elegant gowns for the women who loved to wear them.



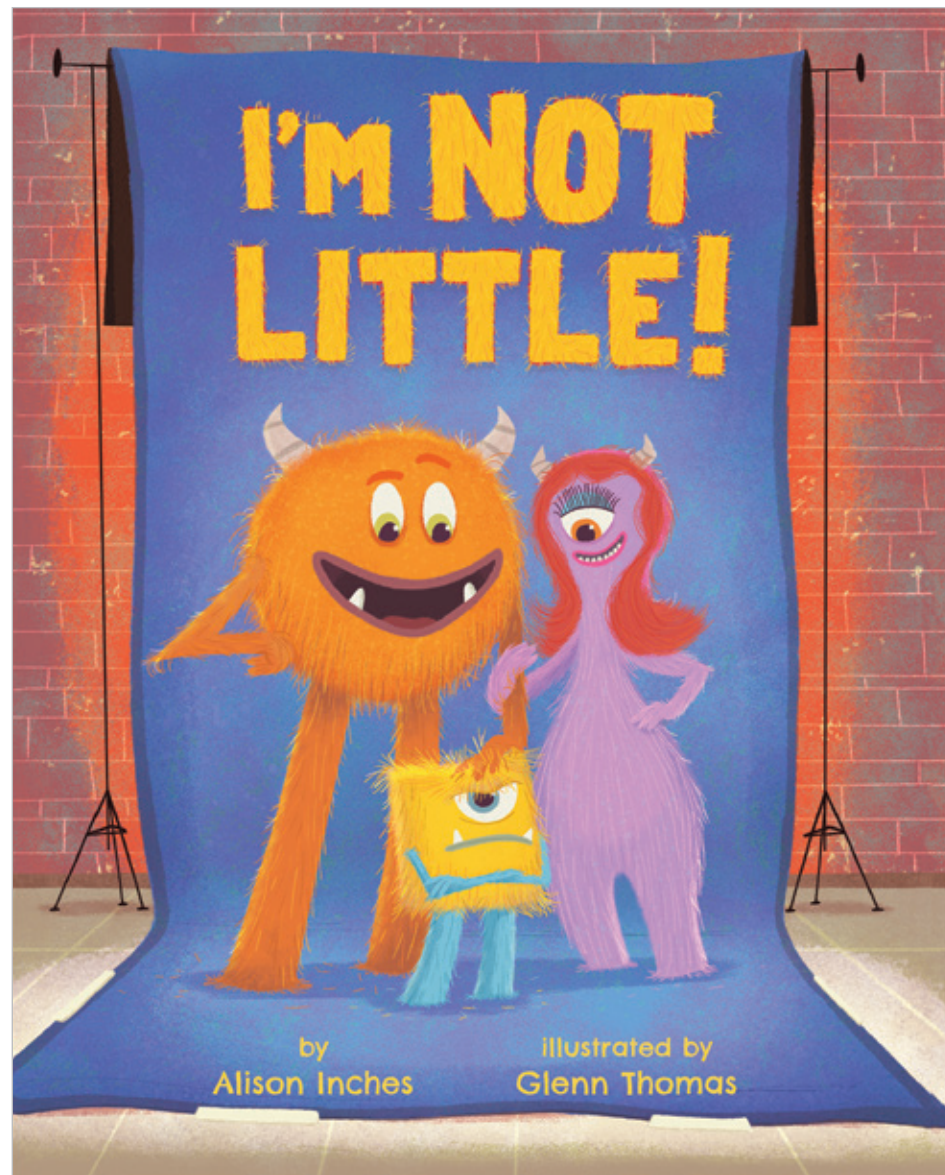
