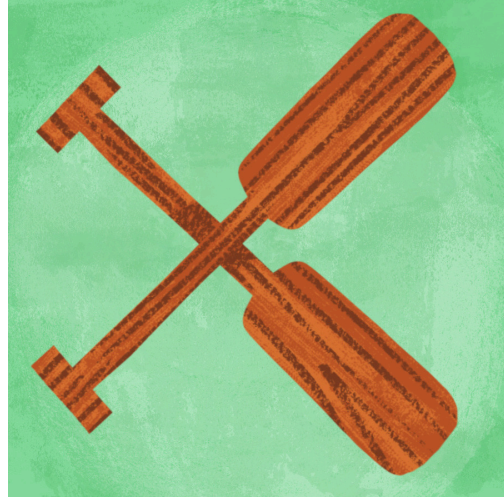
Ready, Set, Sail! Memory Game
