

1) Why do you think some people decided to ride out the storm rather than evacuate?




- 2) What personal objects would you protect from a storm?

- 6) Why did it take residents so long to go back to New Orleans?






## Label the Parts of a Hurricane












## **Complete the Hurricane Katrina Timeline**




Hurricane Katrina hits New Orleans. Katrina becomes a Category 5 hurricane. Katrina becomes a Category 3 hurricane.
