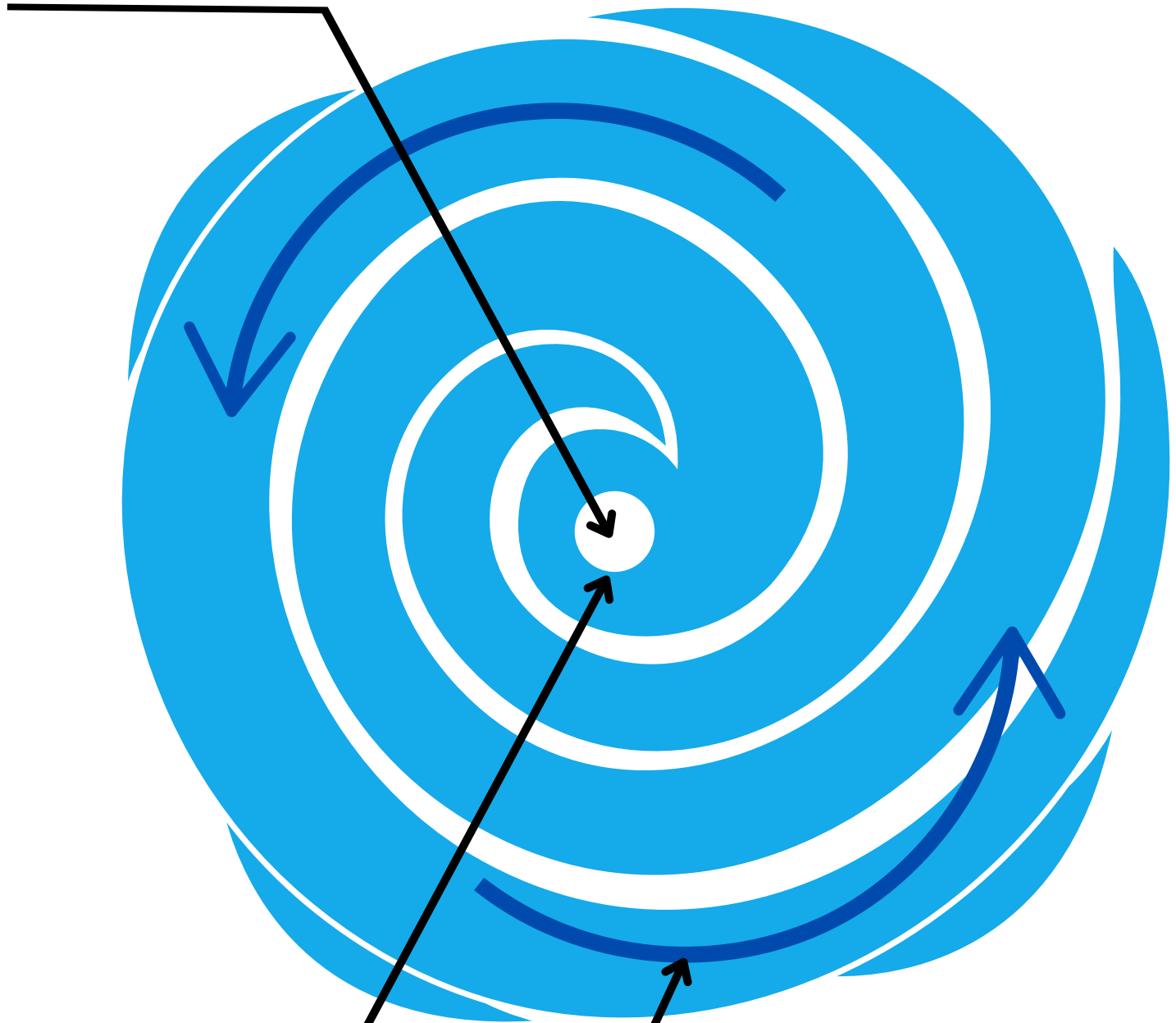


- 1) Why do you think some people decided to ride out the storm rather than evacuate?

Label the Parts of a Hurricane

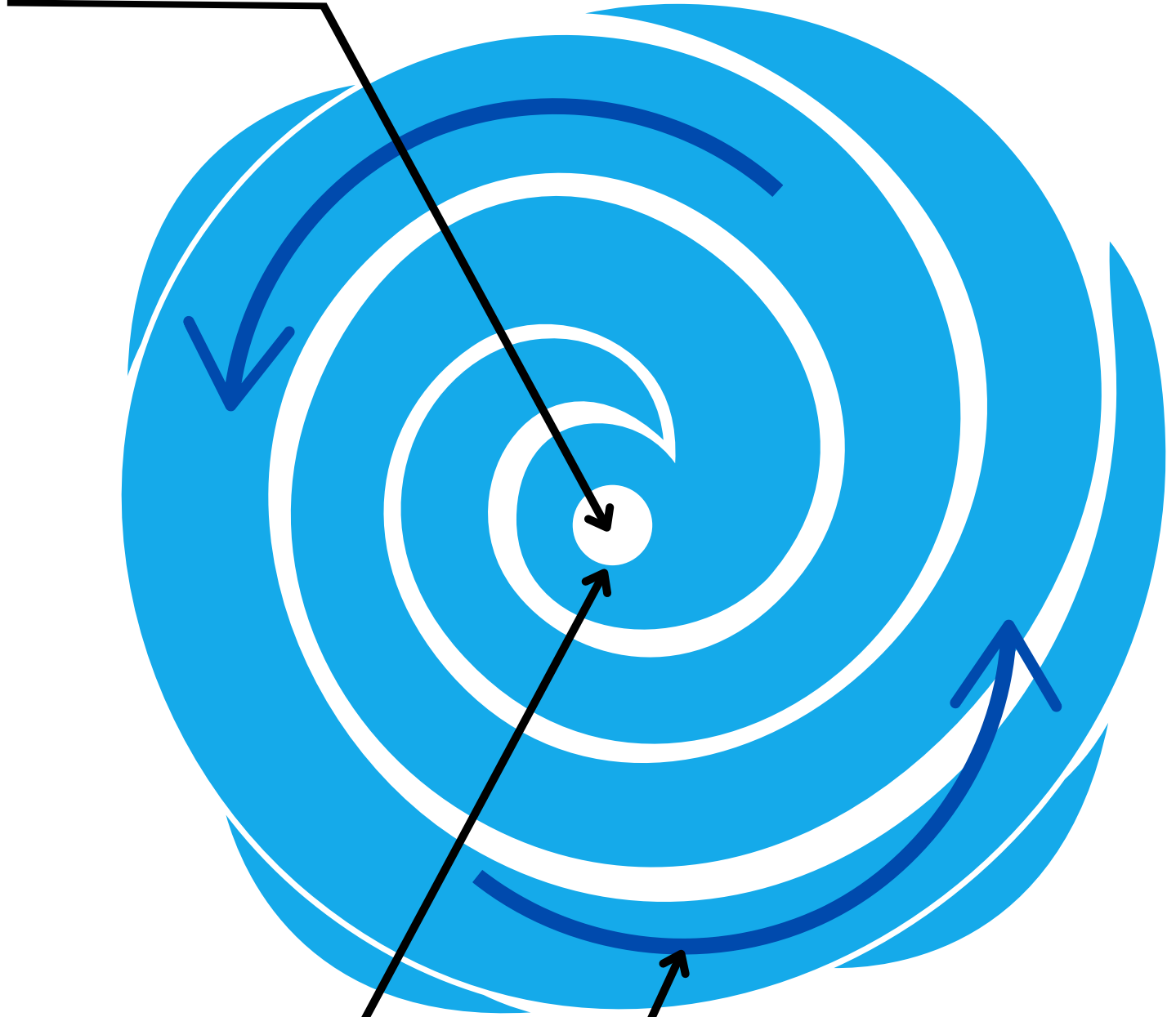

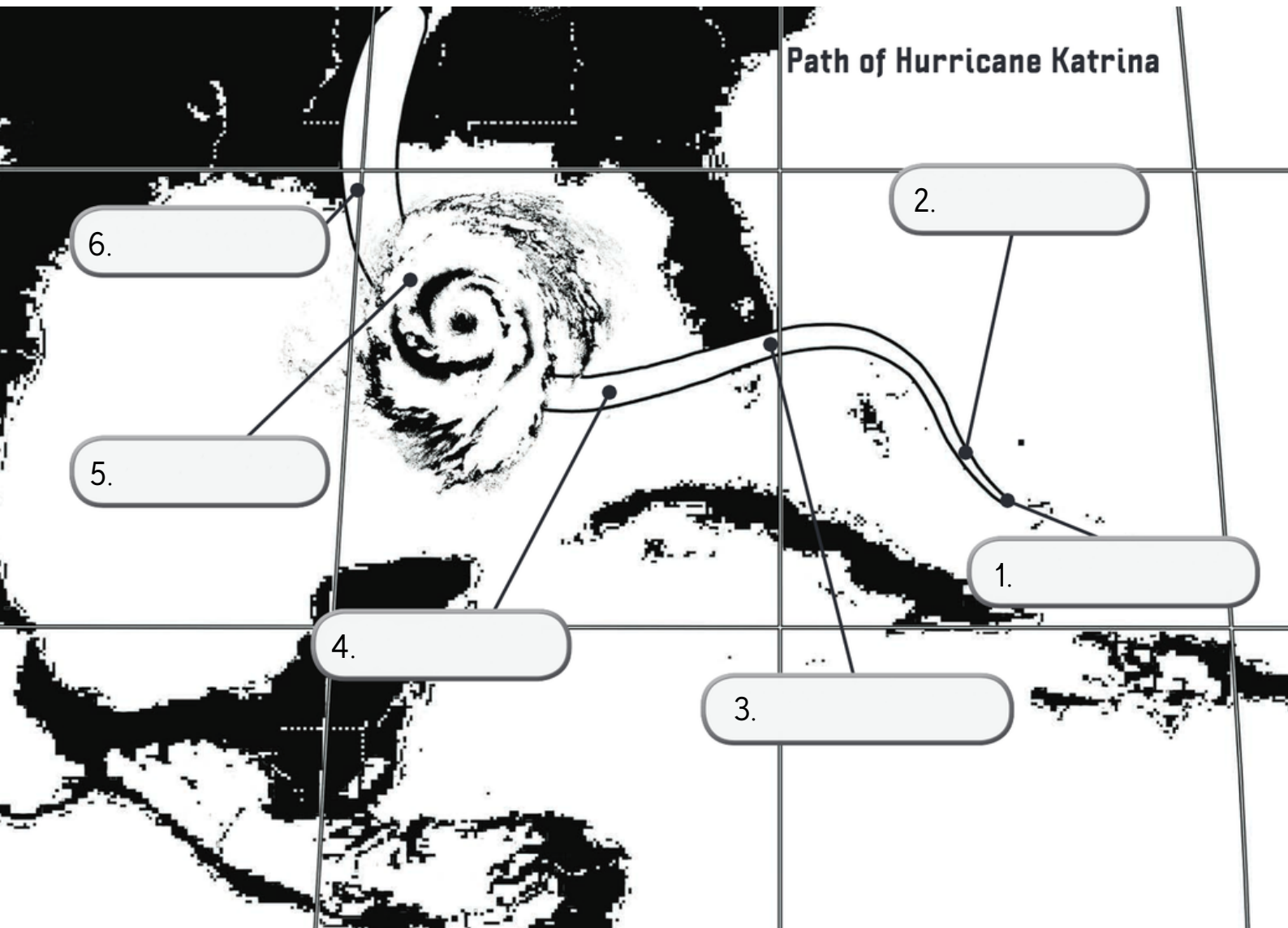

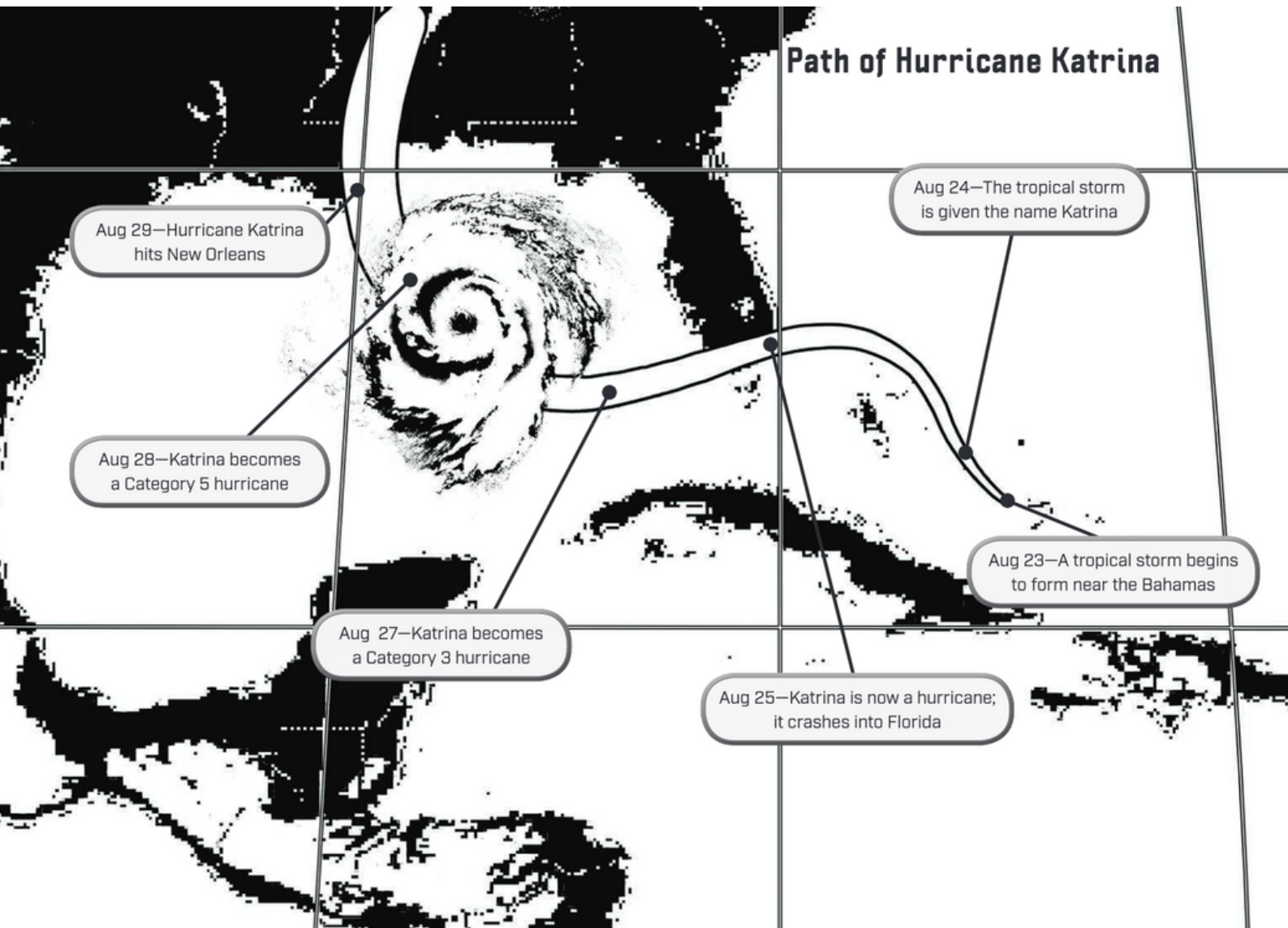
